MEMORANDUM FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE USUHS BRIGADE

SUBJECT: USU Brigade Uniform Policy

1. **Purpose.** This policy prescribes detailed information as to the proper wear of the Service uniforms.
2. **Applicability.** This policy applies to all military personnel assigned to Uniformed Services University (USU). The School of Medicine and the Graduate School of Nursing students will receive guidance from their respective Commandants.
3. **Authority.** This policy is published in accordance with the authority in AR 670-1, 3 February 2005, MCO P1020.34G, 31 March 2003, NAVPERS 15665I, January 2007, AFI 36-2903, 2 August 2006 (Incorporating Change 1, 6 August 2007), and USPHS, Office of the Surgeon General Memo, 9 April 2007.
4. **Policy.** Effective 1 October 2007, USU Brigade personnel are authorized to wear the below Service uniforms.
5. **Description.**

U.S. Army: Army Combat Uniform (ACU) / Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) or Class "A & B" Uniforms
U.S. Navy: BDU or follow Naval District of Washington Uniform guidelines
U.S. Marine Corps: Cammies, Service "C" Uniform (summer), or Service "B" Uniform (winter)
U.S. Air Force: Airman Battle Uniform (ABU) / BDU or Blue Service Uniform
U.S. PHS: BDU, Service Khaki, Service Blue Uniforms (Year round) or Summer White (summer only)

NOTE: A neat and well-groomed appearance by all Service members is fundamental to good military order and discipline. The wear of the USU identification badge is mandatory. The Physical Fitness uniform or apparel will be worn while conducting physical fitness training. Flight suits are authorized to be worn while flying, anticipation of a flight, or when designated by the Brigade Commander. Brigade leadership, Department Chairs, and/or Department Heads may require personnel to wear the same uniform on special occasions, official ceremonies, presentations, formations, and inspections. Exceptions to the duty uniform guidelines will be granted only through the official chain of command. Any questions regarding this policy can be addressed to the Brigade Executive Officer.

This policy will remain in effect until changed in writing by the Brigade Commander.
