Dr. Roopa Biswas is an Assistant Professor in the Nurse Anesthesia Program at the USU Graduate School of Nursing. She is responsible for lecture development as well as the examination and evaluation of student performance.

Prior to joining the University faculty, Dr. Biswas served as a Project Scientist in the department of immunology at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation Lerner Research Institute. While there, she conducted lab research, wrote grants and manuscripts, and served as a classroom instructor.

Dr. Biswas received a bachelor's degree and a master's degree from the University of Calcutta in India prior to receiving a Doctor of Philosophy in biochemistry from Ohio State University. She went on to receive fellowship training at the American Heart Association, Ohio Valley Affiliate.

Dr. Biswas has been honored with many awards throughout her career, including: the USU Outstanding Civilian Faculty Award, the USU Junior Investigator Award for Exceptional Service and the Shanti Bhakta Memorial Award for the Best Seminar Presentation.
