### Interviewing

#### CC/HPI

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *All areas "Excellent" (zero adequate); no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Above average *1-2 areas "Adequate"; no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Acceptable *Three or more areas "adequate"; OR any area rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Unacceptable *Two or more areas either "poor" or "not done"*

#### SH/PMH/PSH/MEDS/Allergies

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Most areas "Excellent" (0-2 adequate); no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Above average *3-5 areas "Adequate"; no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Acceptable *Six or more areas "adequate"; OR any area rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Unacceptable *Three or more areas either "poor" or "not done"*

#### ROS

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Most area excellent; 1-2 areas adequate; no areas poor/superficial*
- Above Average *3-5 areas adequate; no areas poor/superficial*
- Acceptable *5 or more adequate; no more than 2 areas poor/superficial*
- Unacceptable *3 or more areas superficial or not done*

### Physical Exam

#### Thoroughness

##### Organ systems

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *No organ systems omitted*
- Above average *> 50% of one organ system omitted*
- Acceptable *> 50% of two organ systems omitted ; OR one organ system completely omitted*
- Unacceptable *>50% of three or more organ systems omitted; OR two organ systems completely omitted*

##### Exam elements

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Only 0-3 items on the entire checklist omitted*
- Above average *Four or omissions, but majority of the organ systems are complete*
- Acceptable *Omits 1-2 items from the majority of organ systems*
- Unacceptable *Omits 3 or more items from the majority of organ systems*

#### Technique

##### Exam technique

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *1-2 errors in technique*
- Above average *3-5 errors in technique*
- Acceptable *6 or more errors in technique*
- Unacceptable *Major technical errors*

##### Organization

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Polished, smooth flowing exam*
- Above average *Appears well organized; minimal patient repositioning/discomfort*
- Adequate *Reasonably organized; able to get through the exam*
- Poorly organized *Lacks coherent approach; frequent patient repositioning;*

## General Interviewing Skill

### Interviewing skills

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Most areas "Excellent" (0-1 adequate); no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Above average *2 areas "Adequate"; no areas rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Acceptable *Three or more areas "adequate"; OR any area rated "poor" or "not done"*
- Unacceptable *Two or more areas either "poor" or "not done"*

### Patient modesty and comfort

(CHECK ONE BOX)

- Outstanding *Patient draped at all times; frequently validates comfort*
- Attentive *Patient usually draped; occasionally validates comfort with patient*
- Respectful *Some awkwardness or omissions in draping/patient comfort*
- Unacceptable *Lacks adequate concern for patient modesty or comfort*
