SUBJECT: ACLS for Experienced Providers

1. The Military Training Network has added the Advanced Cardiac Life Support for Experienced Providers (ACLS-EP) program to our course catalog. The ACLS Experienced Provider Course (ACLS-EP) is an alternative for seasoned ACLS providers who wish to renew their provider status. The course teaches experienced ACLS providers new information on how to assess and manage critical cardiovascular emergencies not currently addressed in ACLS. Training Sites that are interested conducting ACLS-EP training should review the administrative guidelines found in the [MTN Administrative handbook appendix 5](#). Initiating an ACLS-EP program will be resource intensive. In addition to purchasing the textbooks and toolkits, Training Sites will need to coordinate with civilian AHA Training Centers to acquire initial ACLS-EP instructor training.
