Subject: HEARTSAVER CPR WITH AED COURSE AND HEARTSAVER AED WITH PEDIATRIC CPR

Purpose: To introduce the approved curriculum for two new Heartsaver CPR courses.

Background: These courses were developed to meet the prerequisite needs for the Heartsaver Instructor course and to provide a means for the training network to deliver credentialed training in CPR for adults, children and infants and in Adult AED use using Heartsaver AED *or* Heartsaver CPR textbooks with appropriate supplements. This provides an immediate solution to those instructors who desire to teach the full scope of Heartsaver CPR.

Information: New BLS Provider Courses

1. *Heartsaver CPR With AED*

- Recommended as Day 1 of Heartsaver Instructor Course when primary course to be taught is Heartsaver CPR or CPR in Schools
- Based on Heartsaver CPR Course
- Required books: Heartsaver CPR *and* AED for Heartsaver CPR (70-2568 is a shrink-wrapped combination of both books. AED for Heartsaver CPR is not available as a separate product)
- Skills: Adult CPR, Adult AED, and Pediatric CPR
- Schedule: Adult Heartsaver CPR — use video from Heartsaver tool kit
Adult AED — use AED video section from the Healthcare Provider tool kit
Pediatric Heartsaver CPR — use Heartsaver tool kit
- New tests will be available
- Card: A new Heartsaver card will replace current card. The card will be modular for use in all Heartsaver Courses. Topics not taught should be crossed off. Modules listed are Adult CPR / Adult CPR with AED / Pediatric CPR

2. Heartsaver AED With Pediatric CPR

- Recommended as Day 1 of Heartsaver Instructor Course when primary course to be taught is Heartsaver AED
- Based on current Heartsaver AED Course
- Required books: Heartsaver AED *and* Heartsaver Pediatric CPR (70-2569 is a shrink-wrapped combination of both books. Heartsaver Pediatric CPR is not available as a separate product)
- Skills: Adult CPR, Adult AED, and Pediatric CPR
- Schedule: Heartsaver AED — use Heartsaver AED tool kit
 Pediatric Heartsaver CPR — use pediatric video from Heartsaver CPR tool kit
- New tests will be available
- Card: A revised Heartsaver AED card will include Pediatric CPR, which can be crossed off if not taught
