


## COURSE SUMMARY

This course will consist of a series of lectures and hands-on laboratory sessions covering the diagnosis of parasitic infections of humans. In addition to microscopic examination of specimens, participants will have the opportunity to practice various methods used in the diagnosis of intestinal, blood, and tissue parasitic diseases. Parasitic diseases encountered throughout the world will be included. PowerPoint presentations and video tapes are available for study. The course will be held on the University's campus in Bethesda, Maryland, utilizing up-to-date lecture rooms and laboratory facilities. Microscopes will be available on a loan basis and laboratory supplies will be provided. Certain reference specimens will be available for personal use.


