This will enable the hospital administration to check in all USUHS Students as a group together.

Please arrange your travel plans so that you can arrive by the Friday immediately following your first 2 days at USUHS. On following Monday morning, you will meet with Ms. Joanna Foy in the General Surgery suite room 267-22. Ms. Foy's telephone is 210-916-0439. Email: joanna.foy2@amedd.army.mil Ms. Foy will then refer the MS-IIIs to Dr. Rosenthal, who will briefly discuss with them the core surgery lectures and where and when said lectures will be given. Then, he will take the students to their respective rotation sites and personally introduce them to a responsible physician.

Students must consult with their assigned teams regarding time and location of morning rounds. After administrative matters are taken care of you are to report to Ms. Joanna Foy (Program Coordinator) in the General Surgery Service. Check with Laura Toscano for exact location and room number for Ms. Foy. You will be given a lecture schedule, an on-call roster, and assigned to a "team" at that time. The packet contains a lecture schedule and some sound advice on how to have a successful rotation at BAMC. She will be a point of contact and answer any questions you may have.

Dr. Tom LeVoyer is the General Surgery program director. USUHS MS-III rotations in Surgery are coordinated by Dr. Rosenthal. Dr. Rosenthal or Ms. Foy will give an orientation talk to all students within the first week of each rotation and will be the student's primary point of contact for questions and general advice.

Transportation on Ft. Sam Houston is best accomplished by automobile, and rental cars will be provided, however, bus transportation is available. The BOQ is much too far from the hospital to walk to and from. Taxi rates from the San Antonio International Airport range are reasonably priced. Addendum: Due to extensive building projects being carried on at Ft. Sam Houston and BAMC, parking on BAMC grounds is restricted. There are numerous buses ferrying people from Ft. Sam Houston to BAMC practically at all hours. The buses depart from several conveniently situated pick up points where your POV can be parked.

Driving Directions to Brooke Army Medical Center

Coming from I-10/El Paso (North West San Antonio)

From I-10 South merge onto NE I-410 Loop. After 10 miles I-410 will merge with I-35 South. Travel for another 3.5 miles and take Exit 162, Brooke Army Medical Center/Binz-Englemann Rd. At the end of the exit ramp turn right and enter the George C. Beach Ave Gate.

Coming from I-10/Houston (South East San Antonio)

From I-10 North merge onto I-35 North. Travel for 10 miles and take Exit 162, Brooke Army Medical Center/Binz-Englemann Rd. At the end of the exit ramp turn right and enter the George C. Beach Ave Gate.

Coming from San Antonio International Airport (North Central San Antonio)

Exit Airport Blvd onto NE I-410 Loop. After 5 miles I-410 will merge with I-35 South. Travel for another 3.5 miles and take Exit 162, Brooke Army Medical Center/ Binz-Englemann Rd. At the end of the exit ramp turn right and enter the George C. Beach Ave Gate.

Binz-Englemann Rd Gate Access

This gate is open 24 hours and persons entering will only have access to BAMC. All occupants of vehicles (over the age of 16) are required to present current photo identification with an expiration date (examples: military identification card, state drivers license or state identification card). If the vehicle does not have a valid DOD sticker a Visitor Daily Pass is required. To obtain the pass you must show your drivers license and explain the reason you are requesting access to the installation. You may be asked to show your motor vehicle registration and proof of insurance. All vehicles entering the installation are subject to search while on the installation.
