The fiscal year 2012 program announcements supersede the FY 2011 program announcements. Importantly, and as shown in the figures on pages 2 and 3, TSNRP offers awards for nurses at all stages of their careers. The research awards are the:

- a) Military Clinician-Initiated Research Award,
- b) Graduate Research Award,
- c) Novice Investigator Award,
- d) Exploratory Research Award,
- e) Career Development Award,
- f) Investigator-Initiated Award, and
- g) Fast Track Award

The evidence-based practice awards are the:

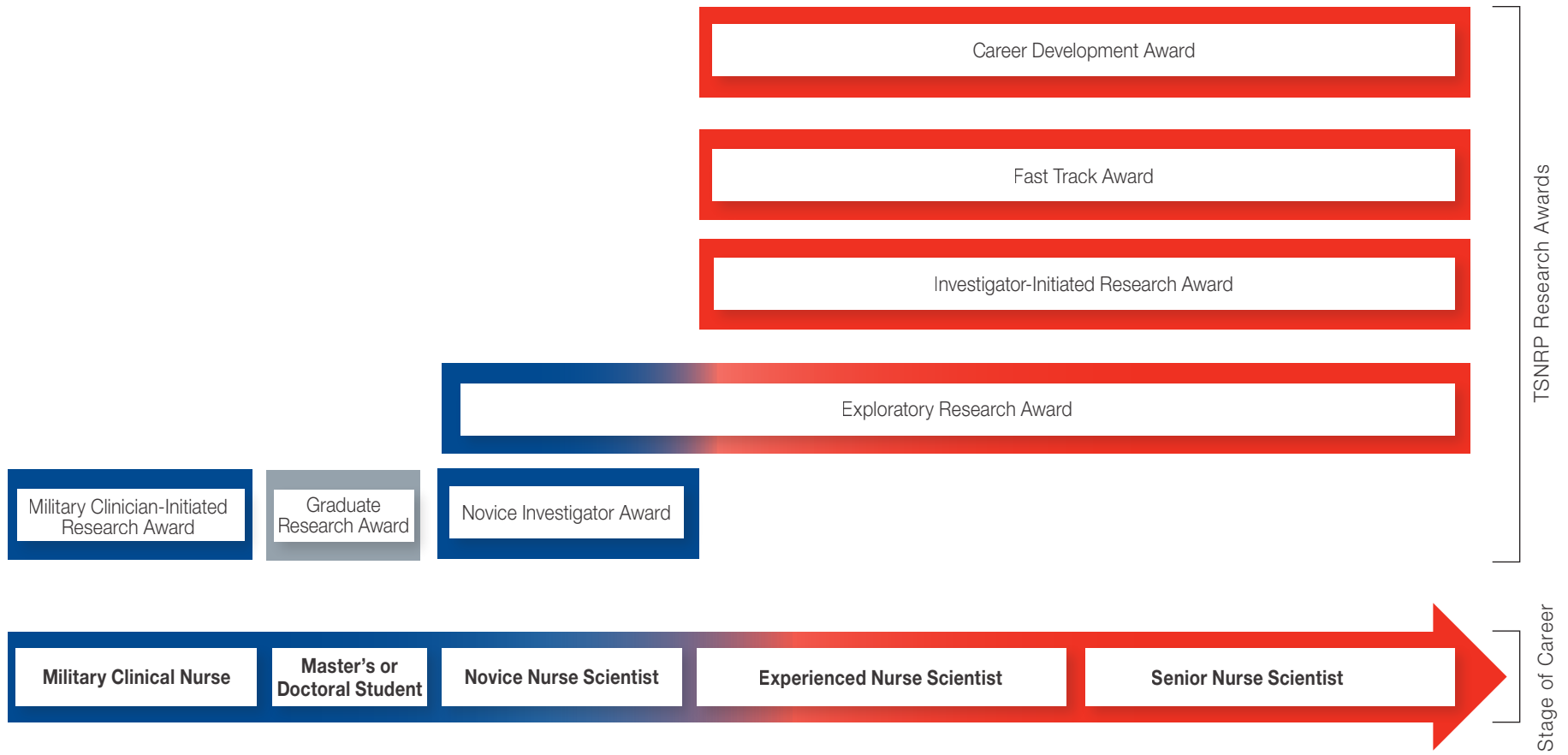
- a) Graduate Evidence-Based Practice Award,
- b) Conceptual Guideline Development Evidence-Based Practice Award, and
- c) Implementation of Innovation Evidence-Based Practice Award

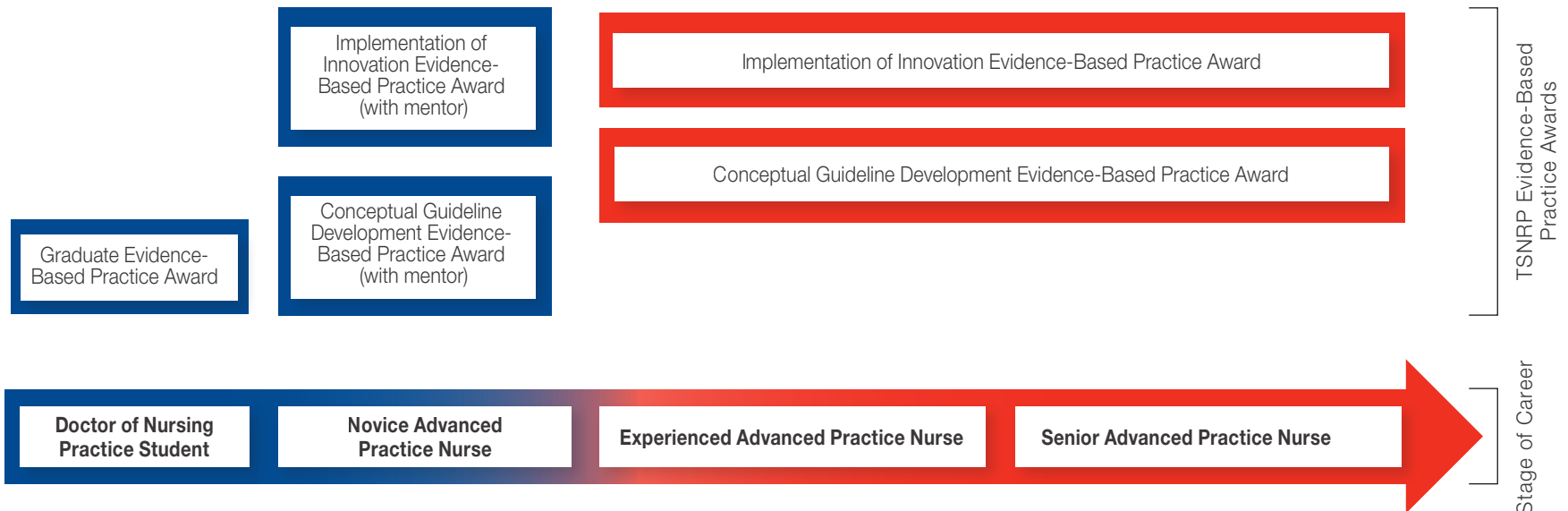
