

I. INTRODUCTION

The TriService Nursing Research Program (TSNRP) Call for Proposals introduces the Program funding priorities and announces the availability of grant funds for FY 2010 and application guidelines for these funds. This Call for Proposals outlines TSNRP's funding priorities and contains information about deadlines and format requirements.

Military nurses applying for TSNRP funding should be familiar with each section of this Call for Proposals. **Pay strict attention** to requirements for the award categories.

All forms needed to apply for TSNRP funding are available online at <http://www.usuhs.mil/tsnrp/GrantApplications/forms.php>. Page 19 contains a table showing the forms needed for each type of award application and sample forms. Applicants should use only the most current application forms.

The Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences (USU) is the granting authority for TSNRP's congressionally appropriated funds and can award grants only to organizations outside the federal sector. **USU's granting authority is limited to nonprofit organizations and academic institutions.** Investigators may submit applications through a non-federal **nonprofit** or **academic** applicant (grantee) organization of their choice. Appendix B contains information on nonprofit organizations frequently used by military personnel.

U.S. Department of Defense and federal government regulations govern research funded by TSNRP. Please refer to Section X, Additional Information. Appendices I and J contain the Terms and Conditions for TSNRP awards.

TSNRP provides education about investigator responsibilities in the **Post-Award Workshop. All successfully funded candidates are required to attend this workshop**, usually held in August of the funding year. If you have been awarded funding and have not attended this workshop, contact TSNRP.
