

II. FUNDING CYCLE

The deadline for the submission of applications for Novice Investigator; 1-, 2-, and 3-Year; Pilot Project; Research Fellow; Evidence-based Practice; Fast Track; and Feasibility Awards is **4 p.m. Eastern Standard Time on the due date**. All applications submitted for these awards will undergo the same review process and follow the same funding cycle. See **Section VIII, Proposal Evaluation**, for Scientific Review Criteria for Novice Investigator; 1-, 2-, and 3-Year; Graduate; Pilot Project; Fast Track; and Feasibility Study Awards. *A Letter of Intent is required for each submission.*
